

Identifying Your Chain

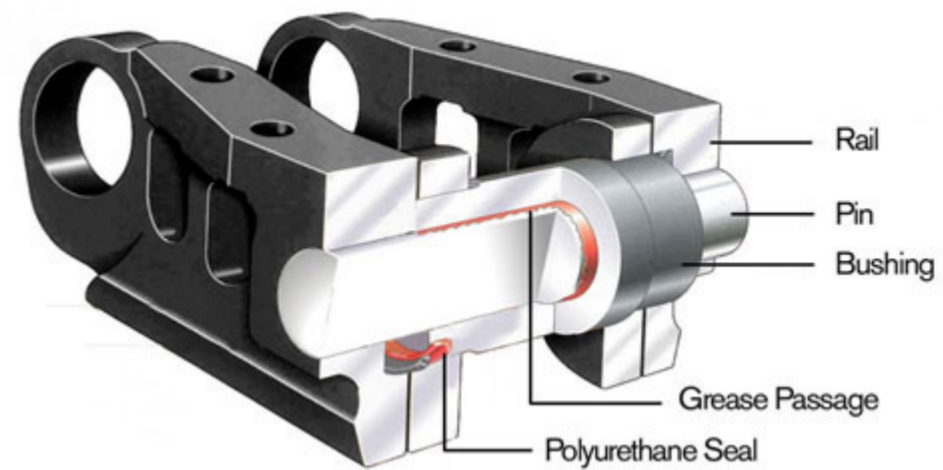
It's Important to know which type of chain you have on your machine. And which will work best for not only your Application, but your Budget. There are two types of chains.

A Sealed and Greased Chain (Dry Chain)

This chain is going to have a standard PRESS-FIT pin and bushing style link assembly which will consist of:

- Right-Hand Link
- Left-Hand Link
- Bushings
- Seals
- Grease Passage
- Pin

Although some Dry Chains will have an Alligator Master link the easiest way to spot a Sealed and Greased Chain is to look at the Master link which will be held together by a single Master Pin that connects the two ends of the chain together.

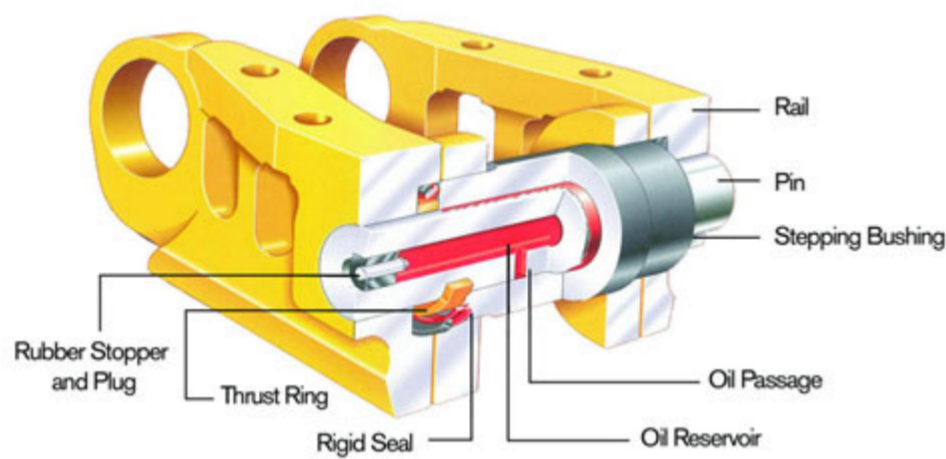


A SALT Chain (Sealed And Lubricated Track)

A SALT Chain (Sealed And Lubricated Track) is going to be more of a heavy duty chain which is typically used for a Dozer Application.

This chain has a lubricated Oil Passage for each individual link consisting of:

- Right-Hand Link
- Left-Hand Link
- Bushings
- Rubber Stopper
- Thrust Ring
- Seal
- Oil Passage
- Pin



One of the Easiest ways to tell if you have a SALT rail is to look at the Master Link which will have what is known as an Alligator Style Link.
